Then after the Galapagos and before Machu Picchu, you'll travel to culturally vibrant Lima, Peru, as well as Cusco, once the capital of the Inca Empire. You'll tour the Sacred Valley's ruins of Incan palaces and temples, along with thriving Andean villages and markets set within landscapes that will simply take your breath away. Your tour concludes enchantingly as you travel to Puno and the amazing man-made Uros Islands scattered across gorgeous and iconic Lake Titicaca!

Town the city boasts the best-preserved historic center in Latin
America, with architecture and rich interiors that fuse Spanish, Italian,
Moorish, Flemish and Indigenous designs. You'll also visit culturally
significant Intiñan Museum and the Equator Line, where you can
straddle across the Northern and Southern Hemispheres! Afterward, you'll
check in to your hotel with the evening at your leisure.

This morning, you'll make the exciting journey to colorful Otavalo in
Imbabura province. Your first visit en route will be to Guayllabamba and
its celebrated market where you can sample the "cherimoya," a traditional
fruit. Continuing on, you'll stop at "Mirador de San Pablo" to view the
stunning landscape of the lake sitting at the foot of Imbabura volcano.
In the afternoon you'll arrive at Otavalo and enjoy lunch at a charming
little restaurant before visiting a handicraft market known as "Plaza de
Ponchos," in which you'll find carpets, wool coats, bags and pottery made
by native Otavalo Indians. You'll also visit the beautiful 50-ft-tall
Peguche Waterfall, an impressive vista that's also a cherished Indigenous
Ceremonial Site. You'll then return to your hotel in Quito to relax and
unwind for the evening.

March 19, 2025 - Arriving in the Galapagos Islands

You'll leave the Ecuadorian mainland from Quito this morning to board

your flight onward to your next great adventure spot, the **Galapagos Islands**! Once you land there on Baltra Island, a guide takes you to Santa Cruz Island across the scenic Itabaca Channel, then up to the **Highlands of Santa Cruz** to check in to your resort. The Galapagos Islands are a living testament to the marvels of evolution, and a haven for **amazing biodiversity**! This pristine archipelago, formed by volcanic activity, is renowned chiefly for its **unique ecosystems** and the **extraordinary wildlife** calling it home. These islands boast a surreal landscape of volcanic craters, lava formations, and pristine beaches, where turquoise waters meet rugged volcanic cliffs in an otherworldly setting captivating all of us who are fortunate enough to experience it! of us who are fortunate enough to experience it!

Today you'll head out to Bartolome Island, a volcanic islet in the Galápagos group just off the east coast of Santiago Island. One of the "younger" islands in the archipelago, Bartolome offers some of the most beautiful Galápagos landscapes, comprising an extinct volcano and a variety of red, orange, green, and glistening black formations. Bartolome has a volcanic cone that's easy to climb and provides great views of the other islands. It's also famous for Pinnacle Rock, the island's most distinctive characteristic and the chief representative landmark in all of the Galápagos! You'll be able to swim and snorkel around Pinnacle Rock, and its underwater world is really impressive, including penguins, marine turtles, white-tipped reef sharks, and other tropical fish.

Overnight: Santa Cruz Is., Galapagos-Ecuador - Royal Palm Hotel (B/L)

March 21, 2025 - Seymour or Plaza Island
You'll explore either Seymour or Plazas Island, whichever is approved

You'll explore either Seymour or Plazas Island, whichever is approved by the local authorities. North Seymour is a small island covered with low, bushy vegetation, and an extraordinary place for breeding birds including one of the largest populations of nesting blue-footed boobies and magnificent frigate birds. Pairs of the boobies can be seen in their mating ritual as they offer each other gifts, whistle and honk, stretch their necks towards the sky, spread their wings, and dance while showing off

their bright blue feet. Despite its small size, South Plaza Island hosts a large number of animal species and is famous for its extraordinary flora. On the steep banks you may see a great number of birds including nesting red-billed tropicbirds and swallow-tailed gulls. The beautiful prickly pear cactus trees and a large colony of **Galapagos Land Iguanas** are quite fascinating as well.

Ôvernight: Santa Cruz Is., Galapagos-Ecuador - Royal Palm Hotel (B/L)

March 22, 2025 - Darwin Research Station and Puerto Ayora In the morning you'll go on your guided tour of the **Charles Darwin Research Station**, which houses museums on the history and development of the Galapagos Islands, as well as information on the protection of their natural heritage. Endemic **giant land turtles** can be seen here, and thanks to the station the many varied turtle populations are not in danger of extinction. You'll then have free time to explore and are not in danger of extinction. You'll then have free time to explore and shop in the port town of **Puerto Ayora**. Later you'll traverse through the cactus forest to **Tortuga Bay**, stopping at **Playa Brava ("Evil Beach")**, so named for its strong currents. You'll find many **marine iguanas**, birds and sea pelicans here. You'll then reach **Mansa Beach**, a natural lagoon where you can see **blue-footed boobies and pelicans**, and perhaps go swimming or sunbathing.

Today you'll fly to Lima, the vibrant capital of Peru where ancient history fully intertwines with modern vitality. You'll encounter well-preserved colonial architecture, churches, and plazas, all offering insights into the country's past and its role in shaping South American history. Today's lunch is included too while visiting the wonderful Larco Museum. 
