Visit the lush green countryside of Kinderdijk, home to the country's greatest concentration of windmills, and experience Amsterdam's distinctive architecture and vibrant nightlife. This is a wonderful opportunity to explore the great medieval cities of Antwerp and Ghent, and delve into the cultural traditions of the friendly Dutch and Flemish people who await you!

Itinerary

March 25, 2023

Today, you'll leave Mountain Home for an overnight in the airport area.
Overnight: Airport Area

March 26, 2023 - Leaving on a Jet Plane

You'll board your overnight flight bound for Amsterdam today!

March 27, 2023 - Amsterdam

On arrival in **Amsterdam** today, you'll be met at the airport and be assisted with your transfer to your hotel. You'll have the remainder of the day at your leisure to relax and unwind. Enjoy dinner on your own, and perhaps begin to explore this unique city of canals, bridges and islands!
Overnight: Amsterdam

March 28, 2023 - Amsterdam Board

You have the morning free to relax or discover Amsterdam at your leisure before you transfer onto the **AmaCerto**, your elegant home for the next 7 nights. After settling in, enjoy a **Welcome Dinner** onboard! (D)

March 29, 2023 - Amsterdam to Hoorn

This morning the ship cruises the **IJsselmeer River** to **Hoorn**, where you have a **choice of four activities**. The first is a visit to a **family-run tulip farm**, where you'll learn about growing these flowers, tour greenhouses and discover **over one million tulips in different colors**, species and phases of growth! The second option is a **walking tour of Hoorn**, where you'll tour De Halve Maen, a replica of the Dutch East India Company's most famous ship, and then stroll through this town's beautiful harbor. Your third choice is to visit the **Zuiderzee Museum**, providing insight into the maritime culture and history of the lively Zuiderzee region. Or those feeling more active may choose to join a **guided bike tour** through **West-Friesland**, where windmills, tulip fields and fruit orchards abound. (B/L/D)

March 30, 2023 - Middelburg

After **cruising the Delta** today, you can explore **Middelburg**, which boasts more than 1,000 city monuments, on a **walking tour**. **Alternatively**, you may explore the **Delta Works** storm surge barrier,

which showcases steel doors that are 147 feet wide, an impressive series of dams and Dutch hydraulic engineering. Your third option is a **guided bike tour** through this historic city. (B/L/D)

March 31, 2023 - Ghent and Bruges

Today, you can **choose a full day excursion to Bruges**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, or stay to **explore Ghent** in depth, or perhaps see a bit of each on a **highlights tour of both cities**. Bruges features many marvelous things to see, including Grote Market and the city's historic center. Those who prefer seeing Ghent will have a choice between a **walking tour** and **chocolate tasting**, with highlights like Belfry Hall, the Koornelei, the Graslei and the Castle of the Counts. (B/L/D)

April 1, 2023 - Antwerp, Belgium

This **morning**, you'll have your choice of **three different excursions**. The first is a **walking tour of Antwerp** on which you'll see Antwerp Castle, Grote Market, Brabo Fountain and the city's superb architecture. Your other options are a **visit to Rubens House**, the former home of the famous Flemish Baroque painter, or a **guided bike tour**. This **afternoon**, choose between a **Belgian chocolates and waffles tasting** or a visit to **Floralia**, an annual **spring flower show** that spans over **34 acres** and features approximately **one million bulbs** that are hand-planted each year by the castle staff. (B/L/D)

April 2, 2023 - Rotterdam, Kinderdijk - Schoonhoven

This **morning** there are **four ways** you can discover **Rotterdam**. You can go on a **walking tour of Rotterdam**, nicknamed the "Gateway to Europe," and taste local specialties. Or visit **Delfshaven**, where, on August 1, 1620, the Pilgrims departed on their epic journey aboard the Speedwell before boarding the Mayflower. Alternatively, you can go to **Delft**, home of the painter Johannes Vermeer, Delft Blue earthenware and the Royal House, and visit the **Royal Delft Porcelain Factory** and Museum. For a more active outing, take a bike ride through Rotterdam past its famous landmarks and architecture. In the **afternoon**, venture to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of **Kinderdijk**, a lovely village renowned for having the country's greatest concentration of **windmills**, all from the 18th century. Or you may pedal past the windmills from the seat of a bike. **Tonight** the ship cruises to **Schoonhoven**, where you'll

have some **free time** as we'll moor there overnight. (B/L/D)

April 3, 2023 - Amsterdam

We arrive in **Amsterdam** today. Admire the spectacular display of millions of flowering tulips during your **morning** excursion to the world famous **70-acre Keukenhof Gardens**. In the **afternoon**, enjoy a **scenic cruise** through the historic harbor and **canals of Amsterdam**. See the beautiful homes that line the water, the fabled Skinny Bridge, and the famous house where **Anne Frank** spent years in hiding during World War II. The ship stays overnight in Amsterdam. (B/L/D)

April 4, 2023 - Disembark Amsterdam and fly home

Your cruise comes to an end today. After disembarkation, you'll proceed to the airport for your flight home. **Memories of Holland and Belgium at Tulip Time will be with you for years to come!** (B)
